Registration fees for Czech national breeds – 25 % discount for the first deadline (for the following breeds: český fousek, český terier, český strakatý pes, pražský krysařík, čsl. víčák). Discount for second and other dogs can only be applied if the owner's name is identical with the first entryform. Any change in the second entryform, for example addition of joint ownership, will be treated as a new entryform at full price.

For the purpose of distinguishing payments for the 1st, 2nd and the 3rd deadline, the postal stamp date on the envelope containing the entryform is decisive. The entryform will not be accepted without an evidence of payment!!

Handling fees:

- Cancellation of an exhibitor by the 2nd closing date – CZK 100. After the 2nd closing date is no longer possible to cancel the application
- Reclassification dog to another class at the request of the exhibitor to the third closing date – 100,- CZK. After the final deadline is no longer possible reclassification!

Veterinary conditions:

- All the entered dogs must be clinically healthy.
- Dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies.
- Dogs from EU and third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet the conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003
- If the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans.

Documents for participation at the show:

- Pedigree
- EU Pet passport

Classes: division into classes is governed by Show Regulation of CMKU and FCI and is indicated on the entry form. Color, sizes and type of hair of some breeds are judged separately in compliance with the provisions of FCI or by decision by ČMKU. Awarding of titles can not be entitled.

Expectancy: CAJC, CAC ČR, CAC ČMKU, Res. CAC ČR, CACIB, Res. CACIB

Titles: Best of Breed – BOB, Best of opposite sex – BOS, Best Junior in breed – BOJ, Best Veteran of breed – BOV, Junior Winner of FCI – JBIG, Junior Winner at the show – JBIS, winner of FCI group – BIG, winner of the show – BIS.

Competitions:

Junior Handling – age groups: I. 9–13 years, II. 13–17 years, to achieve group is counting by date of birth entered one day before the show. Compete can be only with a dog registered in the stud book recognized by the FCI, the dog may not be judged on the show. Assesses the performing dog quality is not important. Points earned in competition on national and international exhibitions may count yearlong, statewide competition.

Saturday – Best of National Breeds (BONB) – competition for all individuals Czech FCI recognized and FCI non-recognized breeds including Czechoslovakian wolfdog.

Best Puppy – To enter the competition, all males/ females who were honored at an exhibition in puppy class very promising I.

Best Veteran – competing of dogs, who received the title Best Veteran BOV.

Best of Honour class – competing of dogs, who received Exc. 1 in honour class.

Best Couple – a male and a female of the same breed and variety presented at the show, owned or co-owned by the same person(s). The co-ownership must be confirmed by a record in the pedigree.

Best Breeder's Group – 3 – 5 individuals of the same breed and variety, which have been judged at the show, which come from the same kennel and which have at least two different fathers or mothers.

Junior Group Winner (JBIG) – competing by FCI groups. For all dogs, who received the title BOJ

Group Winner (BIG) – competing of dogs with title BOB, judging by groups FCI

Junior Best of Day (JBOD) – competing of dogs, who won JBIG
Best of Day (BOD) – competing for dogs, who won the FCI groups
Junior Best in Show (JBIS) – competing of winners JBOD
Best in Show (BIS) – competing for dogs, who won BOD

Instructions for application completion: Applications should be completed in block letters. Each dog has its own application. Illegible applications will not be accepted. For incorrectly completed application organizer is not responsible. For each application, the entryform must include a photocopy of both sides of pedigree. In the case of a payment by postal service, support the entryform at least with a photocopy of payment. A dog can be entered only in one class. If the application is missing attached photocopy of proof that the dog meets the conditions for the working or champion class, will be placed in the open class. To access the honor class is required to prove title to justify the inclusion of a dog in this class. To documents sent after the third deadline will not be considered. Acceptance of a dog to the show will be about 10 days before the show electronically send to your e-mail address. If you don't receive the confirmation, please contact the show office. An exhibitor agrees with publication of his address in the catalog.

General provisions: The exhibition is accessible to males and females of all breeds registered in the books recognized by the FCI that reached the day of the show the age required for class. Organizers are not responsible for damages caused by a dog or an exhibitor, or for dog loss or death during the exhibition. The fairgrounds are not allowed to move freely dogs. During the show will be a random inspection of the identity of dogs (tattoo nr./chip) according to the regulations of CMKU. **The exhibition will not be admitted dog with cropped ears and will not be judged.** Show is not open for females in season, females in the second half of pregnancy, nursing females and aggressive individuals. It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose of the dog anything that changes their texture, color or shape. It is forbidden to treat the dog on the show grounds, using any substances or equipment. Allowed only cutting, trimming, combing and brushing. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the table at the show. Violation of this provision may result in immediate expulsion from the show. Owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions. Exhibitors are required to comply with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations and ČMKU, these propositions and the instructions of Show Committee, which will undertake the filing. Exhibitor acknowledges that it is required to maintain order in the exhibition area. If the show does not take place due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the expenses. Taking puppies for sale at the show is prohibited. Organizer assumes no responsibility for not delivery entryforms. If more than 80 dogs are entered for the judge, there is no need to write show reports after agreement with the organizer.

Exhibitors at the CMKU show are responsible for the welfare of dogs. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could endanger his health or well-being, such as leaving him in a vehicle for extraordinary heat or winter, respectively behave in a rough way. Violations of this Regulation will result in exclusions from the following exhibitions.

Protest: A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of 1600 CZK, during the course of the show. If the protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.
