ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Entry takes place via the online system www.dogoffice.cz. Each user must have their personal account set up in the system. In the section My dogs you will establish your dogs and add there the necessary attachments (Pedigree of both parts, including the part where the owner is listed). The owner registered in the pedigree must be the same as the username of the account in dogoffice.cz. If the dog is co-owned, an account in the dogoffice.cz must be established under the same names.

After the successful registration you will receive a confirmation message, you will also see your application status in the section „ APPLICATIONS“ . After completing your registration the system will generate a variable symbol for the payment. The application is only valid after being paid!

The organizer reserves the right to cancel unpaid entries without urgency. A dog can only be entered in one class. Entry forms are available in the system www.dogoffice.cz about 7 days before the exhibition.

HANDLING FEES

Cancellation of the entry by exhibitor on the closing date – half of your entry fee.

Reclassification of a dog to another class by the exhibitor request to the last closing date – 15 €.

After the final deadline it is no longer possible to cancel the entry!

The fee must be paid under the same variable symbol as the application number; afterwards, please request reclassification and attach the payment confirmation.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS

All the entered dogs must be clinically healthy.

Dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid rabbies vaccination.

Dogs from EU and the third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet the conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003.

All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of their dogs not to cause any damage to other dogs or humans.

CLASSES

The division into classes is governed by Show Regulation of CMKU and FCI and is indicated on the entry form. Color, sizes and type of hair of some breeds are judged separately in compliance with the provisions of FCI or by the decision by ČMKU.

EXPECTANCY

Awarding of titles can not be entitled.

TITLES

- BOB** – Best of Breed
- BOS** – Best of opposite sex
- BOJ** – Best Junior in Breed
- BOV** – Best Veteran of Breed
- Best of Minor Puppy** – Best Minor Puppy of Breed
- Best of Puppy** – Best Puppy of Breed
- JBIG** – Junior Winner of FCI
- JBOD** – Junior Winner of the Day
- JBIS** – Junior Winner at the Show
- BIG** – Winner of FCI Group
- BOD** – Winner of the Day
- BIS** – Winner of the Show

FINAL COMPETITIONS

Junior handling – age groups:

I. 9–13 years, II. 13–18 years (the required age must be reached one day prior to the show date).

Best Minor Puppy – competition of puppies who received the title „Best of Minor Puppy”

Best Puppy – competition of puppies who received the title „Best of Puppies”

Best Veteran – competition of dogs, who received the title Best Veteran BOV.

Best of Honour class – competition of dogs, who received Exc. 1 in Honour class.

Best Couple – a male and a female of the same breed and variety presented at the show, owned or co-owned by the same person(s). The co-ownership must be confirmed by a record in the pedigree.

Best Breeder's Group – 3 – 5 individuals of the same breed and variety, which have been judged at the show and come from the same kennel and have at least two different fathers or mothers.

Junior Group Winner (JBIG) – competition by FCI groups. For all the dogs, who received the title BOJ.

Group Winner (BIG) – competition of the dogs with the title BOB, judging by groups FCI.

Junior Best of Day (JBOD) – competition of the dogs, who won JBIG.

Best of Day (BOD) – competition for the dogs, who won the FCI groups.

Junior Best in Show (JBIS) – competition of the winners JBOD.

Best in Show (BIS) – competition for the dogs, who won BOD.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The exhibition is accessible to males and females of all breeds registered in the books recognized by the FCI that reached the age required for the class on the day of the show. Organizers are not responsible for any damages caused by a dog or an exhibitor, or for the loss or death of the dog during the exhibition. The fairgrounds are not allowed to move dogs freely. During the show there will be a random inspection of the identity of dogs (tattoo nr./chip) according to the regulations of CMKU.

The exhibition will not be admitted to a dog with cropped ears and this dog will not be judged. The show is not open for females in the second half of pregnancy, nursing females and aggressive dogs. It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose of the dog with anything that changes their texture, color or shape. It is forbidden to treat the dog on the show grounds, using any substances or equipment. Cutting, trimming, combing and brushing are allowed. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the table at the show. Violation of this provision may result in the immediate expulsion from the show. The owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions. The exhibitors are required to comply with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations and ČMKU, these propositions and the instructions of Show Committee, which they undertake by submitting an application. Exhibitor acknowledges that it is required to maintain order in the exhibition area. If the show does not take place due to any force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the show expenses. Taking puppies for sale at the show is prohibited. The organizers assume no responsibility for not delivery of the entry forms. If there are more than 80 dogs entered for one judge, there is no need to write show reports after agreement with the organizer. Leaving the dog in a vehicle without human supervision is allowed only exceptionally and for a short time. In this case, the dog must be provided with sufficient air, space or light, as well as a suitable ambient temperature (eg functional air conditioning in summer and heating in

winter). Keeping the dog in a confined space of the vehicle for longer can be considered as a cruelty.

Exhibitors at the CMKU show are responsible for the welfare of dogs. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could endanger his health or well-being, such as leaving him in a vehicle for extraordinary heat or cold respectively behave in a rough way. Violations of this Regulation will result in exclusions from the following exhibitions.

Photos and videos can be taken at the exhibition. By visiting the event, the viewer accepts that they may be subject to photography and records. The photographer must be notified of any objections to this directly.

PROTEST

A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The protest must be submitted in a written form, against a deposit of 2200 CZK, during the course of the show. If the protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.

The organizer reserves the right to make any changes.
